Election Heat Taking Toll on DA's Office

District Attorney Jennifer Tharp has never won a contested election. She was appointed to

the job in 2010 and even though she ran unchallenged later that year, 20% of the electorate voted for somebody else. Ouch.

This time around she's got three Republican challengers, and judging from statements made by two of her staff members, desperation is the word of the day.

On January 29, Comal County's Chief Misdemeanor Prosecutor, Clayten Hearrell, had this to say about the three GOP candidates running to be the next person to sign his checks:

"Every habitual felony offender in that jail is hoping that Soane can somehow win the election, every violent gang member hopes the winner will be de Lemos, and every single child molester hopes that Deborah Wigington somehow finds victory."

Holy cow. That's a lot to unpack. Where to start...

No criminal in any jail anywhere wants their current DA to win re-election. What Hearrell asserts might be the weakest argument possible for why any District Attorney should be reelected. Following this logic, we should cancel all future elections for DA because criminals oppose the incumbent. Win once after a death or retirement, keep the job as long as you'd like. Perfect.

Fun with Ad Hominem

To conflate the political wishes of habitual felons, gang members and child molesters with anyone that wants to run for public

office is a dangerous tack.

Hearrell has lumped the candidates in with the worst of society, which implies by extension that anyone supporting those candidates is also siding with criminals.

Are you one of the voters pulling for Wigington, Soane, or de Lemos? Hearrell has made it clear that you're helping gang members and child molesters get their way. Only time will tell if you can find time away from your habitual felony habit to show up at the polls. Thank goodness for early voting.

More Fun with Ad Hominem

Chief Felony Prosecutor, Sammy McCrary, chimed in on the election as well, <sarcasm>with all the respect for due process that one would expect from an American officer of the court </sarcasm>. He went after an area attorney for her legal defense of a local murderer, conflating her work on the case with her support of all three candidates:

"The funny thing is that this defense lawyer who represented that baby killer seems familiar. I wonder where else I have seen her lately? I think she was just saying something about bringing justice back to Comal County."
