

This time around, it's not so much as a "month in review" as it is a preview of the upcoming NBA Finals and my take on the LBJ/MJ debate so let's get to it...

**NBA:** So for the fourth year in a row, we get Cavs vs Warriors in the NBA Finals and a good chunk of hardcore followers are groaning about it as we've seen this story three times over while the casual fan seems to be okay with it since they don't have to reeducate themselves on the players and teams involved.

I'm torn about it. On one hand, the result seems inevitable (which was the case the last three years). On the other hand, Cleveland said to hell to with inevitability and pulled off the greatest Finals comeback ever, overcoming a 3-1 series deficit to beat the Warriors in 7 games in 2016. That stunning upset, as awesome as it was, led to Golden State's signing of Kevin Durant so thank you Cleveland, may the Browns go 3-13 for the next 40 years.

Let's get this out of the way: as Thanos-like as LeBron James can be, there's no way Golden State is losing this series. Admittedly, the Warriors have looked far more vulnerable this season than last when they swept their way through the West and lost just 1 game the entire postseason, a "meh" Game 4 loss in the Finals in Cleveland when Golden State held a 3-0 series lead. This year the Warriors have lost five playoff games already, getting pushed twice by the Chris Paul-less Rockets in Games 6 & 7 of the Conference Finals.

There's also the aforementioned destroyer of planets mentioned above, LeBron James, who already has seven 40 point games and three triple-doubles in the playoffs, two things that have NEVER been done in the same postseason in NBA history. He has dragged \*this\* Cavalier team to the Finals, a team whose second best player varies on the night. Usually, Kevin Love is Cleveland's 2nd best player but Love missed the final two games of the Conference Finals with a concussion, so the Cavs best option outside of LBJ in Cleveland's Game 7 win at Boston was freaking Jeff Green. JEFF GREEN ONCE PLAYED FOR SEATTLE.

Seriously, take 10 minutes out of your day and look up the Cavalier roster, it will blow your mind. The combined amount of All-Star appearances from the roster outside of LeBron is six and five of those belong to Love, the other being Kyle Korford (Go 2015 Hawks!). Even if you took away the combined 14 All-Star games between Steph Curry and Kevin Durant, the rest of the Warriors roster has played in 10 All-Star games collectively. Jordan Clarkson, George Hill, Tristan Thompson and Larry Nance Jr. are supposed to compete with that?

Maybe LeBron can will them to pull it off. Maybe the Warriors are starting to show some cracks in the foundation. Maybe Durant isn't such a great fit after all. I'm just not buying it. Prepared to be wowed by LeBron yet again but in only five games as the Warriors cruise to their second straight title and third in the last four years.

Assuming that does happen, it will mark the sixth finals loss in LeBron's career, dropping his Finals record to 3-6. The calls of "Michael Jordan never lost in the Finals, this is why LeBron will never be better than MJ" will come pouring in on sports talk shows and social media. You have my permission to shut both off and go outside instead because that argument is weak.

Look at the teams Jordan faced in the Finals: an over-the-hill Lakers team in '91, good-not-great Blazers and Suns teams in '92 & '93, a really good Sonics (R.I.P.) team in '96, and two very good Jazz teams in '97 & '98. Those teams all had great players, including Magic Johnson, James Worthy, Clyde Drexler, Terry Porter, Clifford Robinson, Gary Payton, Shawn Kemp, John Stockton, Karl Malone and Greg Ostertag\*, but is that collection better than what LeBron has faced?

#### \*Ostertag was not great

In his first Finals in 2007, LeBron was nowhere near his prime and faced a far superior Spurs team with Tim Duncan, Tony Parker and Manu Ginobili all in their primes. Dallas' 2011 team was really good, albeit arguably the only team LeBron shouldn't have lost to in the Finals. The 2014 Spurs were far better than anything Jordon faced and the 2015 & 2017 Warriors are in the conversation for some of the greatest teams

Seriously, take 10 minutes out of your day look up the Cavalier roster, it will blow mind. The combined amount of All-Star earances from the roster outside of LeBron and five of those belong to Love, the other seriously, take 10 minutes out of your day EVER. LeBron's Finals wins have come over an Oklahoma City team featuring three future MVPs, a Spurs team in 2013 that was identical to the one that beat him a year later, and the 2016 Warriors who won 73 @\$%ing games.

Also consider what LeBron is doing in his 15th season while Jordan, in his 15th (and final) season was playing for a Washington Wizards team that finished 37-45. This is not to disparage the greatness of Jordan. No player, LeBron included, instilled more fear in opponents than Jordan did. Every time Jordan played against your team, you wondered what new way he would find to beat you. He was as cold-blooded of a player that we will ever see.

With LeBron, it's a different sense of awe, one that's hard to explain and one that I don't want to. I just want to enjoy watching him play while it lasts. It was tough watching Jordan put on that Wizards uniform and play for a below-average team to finish out his career. Could you imagine what it would be like if LeBron, say 5 years from now, was suiting up for the Kings in 2023 as they finished 30-52?

I had a text exchange with a friend recently about LeBron, and the sentiment between us was that we need to behold LBJ while we can and shame on anyone for questioning his career. One of the things that Jordan had going for him was that he played in an era without social media (god just imagine Twitter when he announced he was playing baseball) while LeBron has had a target on his back since he was in high school.

So my plea to you as you watch the upcoming NBA Finals is this: let's all just chill on all of the LeBron/MJ debates and be grateful that we've been able to witness both. If you're younger than 25 and didn't get to watch Jordan play, then go to YouTube but also punish yourself for not being born sooner by also watching clips of Greg Ostertag.




